## MAKE A WILL...



If you wish, you can leave something in your will to support the Kilkenny SPCA work in helping cruelly treated, neglected and abused animals.

Large donations are great, but even a small gift can truly make a difference to an animal that is suffering.

If you decide to support the Kilkenny SPCA in your will, it's advisable that you consult your solicitor, who can help you with the legal formalities.

There are different types of bequests that you can make:

- A Pecuniary Bequest: a gift of a specific amount of money.
- A Residuary Bequest: the rest of your property that you have not already given away.
- A Specific Bequest: a gift of a specific item.

If you already have a will, it's easy to amend it. Minor changes do not require a new will. The existing will can be amended by preparing a document called a *codicil*, which your solicitor will help you to draw up.

*By making a bequest you can make a real difference for the thousands of animals in need in Ireland, and leave a better country to the future generations.*

## OUR AIMS...

1. To prevent cruelty to all animals, domestic and wild
2. To inspect reported and suspected cases of cruelty or neglect and advise the Gardai accordingly
3. To provide shelter for distressed animals
4. To provide for the treatment of injured and sick wild animals, with the intention of releasing them back into the wild
5. To help rehome animals

*Along with the increased number of animals in Co. Kilkenny in recent years, there has been a corresponding increase in the number of cases of neglect and outright cruelty to animals*

## WE NEED...

1. Our own animal shelter for the animals in our care
2. To appoint a full-time professional inspector and to remunerate that person adequately
3. To meet promptly on-going veterinary charges
4. To replace the animal ambulance
